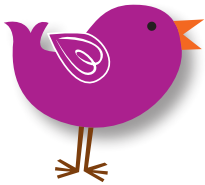

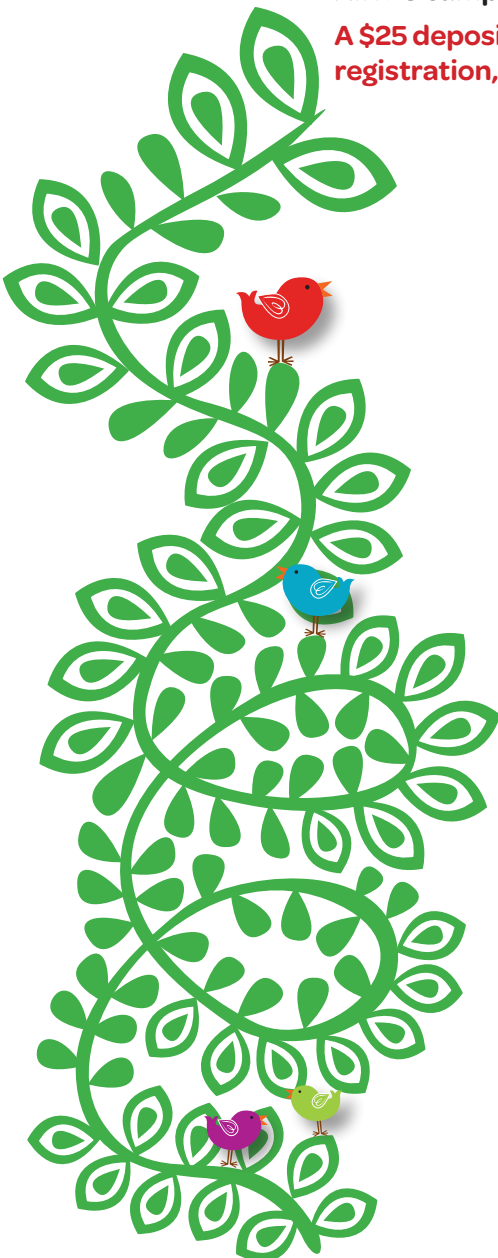
A Splashing Good Time!
