**Tots** These day camps offer child care for volunteers working at day camp who have younger children (typically 3-5 years old).



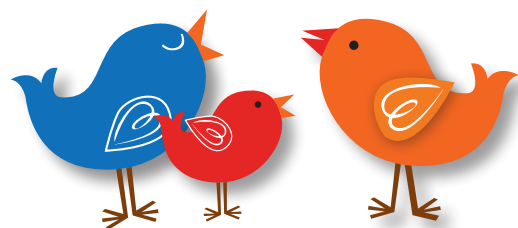
**Boys** These day camps offer child care for volunteers working at day camp who have boys (typically grades 1-5).

**Volunteer Discount** These day camps offer a discount for your daughter when you volunteer.



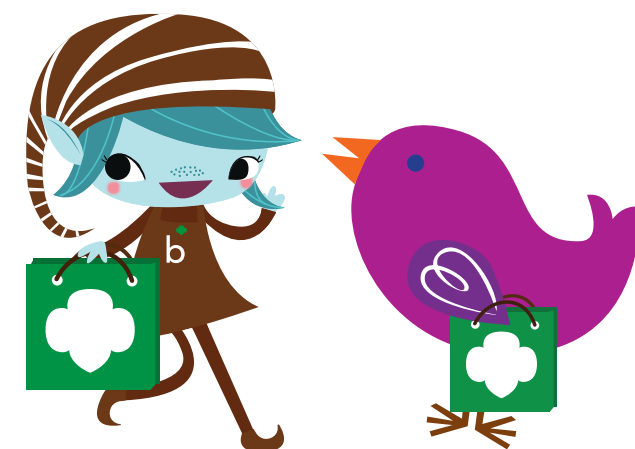
