General Information

Bridge to the Next Century is open to all registered Girl Scouts, Girl Scout alumnae, their families and friends of Girl Scouting.

What is the cost of the event?

The Bridge to the Next Century Activity Bracelet gives you admission to all of the event locations. The bracelet includes local bus transportation around the event. Participants will also receive an event patch*.

Early Registration (by February 1, 2013): \$15 per person

Registration (after February 1, 2013): \$20 Registration

Roster

A complete roster with first and last names must accompany your registration form in order for it to be processed. Forms that do not have completed rosters cannot be processed. If all participants in your group will be purchasing an activity bracelet and a concert bracelet, you may use one roster.

Radio Disney Concert Bracelet

Early Registration (by February 1, 2013): Floor Seats: \$20; Mezzanine: \$18; Balcony: \$15

Registration (after February 1, 2013): Floor Seats: \$25; Mezzanine: \$23; Balcony: \$20

Seats will be general admission within your purchased seating level.

May I register for just the concert or the daytime activities, or do I need to register for both?

You may register for just the daytime activities, or just the concert, but we hope you will register for both.

Do parents/leaders have to pay to participate?

Yes, the fee covers costs associated with the entire event.

May individual girls attend the event?

Individual girls are welcome to sign up for the event, however, they must be accompanied by an adult.

Can I volunteer to help with the event?

Yes, this program would not be possible without volunteers. Individuals who volunteer, will receive a discount on their registration. If you are interested in volunteering for this event, please email us at fab5volunteers@gshom.org.

What if we only want to do part of the event?

This event is designed so you can do as little or as much as you want. You can come and go as you please. Registration cost is the same no matter how many activities you participate in.

Registration

Early Registration deadline is February 1, 2013

Registration is February 2 through February 27, 2013. After February 27, you must register at the event. **Due to the nature of the Radio Disney Concert, purchase of tickets at the event may be limited to certain seating areas.**

Cancellations and refunds

Cancellations must be submitted by February 1, in writing. Refunds will NOT be given for cancellations received after February 1 or for failing to attend the event. Your registration may be transferred to another troop or individual.

Financial assistance

Please check your council guidelines for financial assistance.

Is bussing available from other regions?

Yes, bussing is available from several locations. There is an additional fee of \$15 per person for bussing. The busses will arrive in time for the opening ceremony and leave around 9 p.m. or when the concert ends.

Is food available?

Troops are responsible for their own food. You can purchase food from one of the many restaurants or you are welcome to bring your own food. We will place dining deals from local restaurants on our Web site as we receive them.

Go Green

Help reduce waste and bring a water bottle with you. Better yet, purchase your very own Girl Scouts Forever Green water bottle.

Is lodging available?

Yes, lodging will be available. GSHOM is working with local hotels to have a special Girl Scout discount. A link to hotels that are offering Girl Scout discounts will be available at GSHOM.org by the end of January.

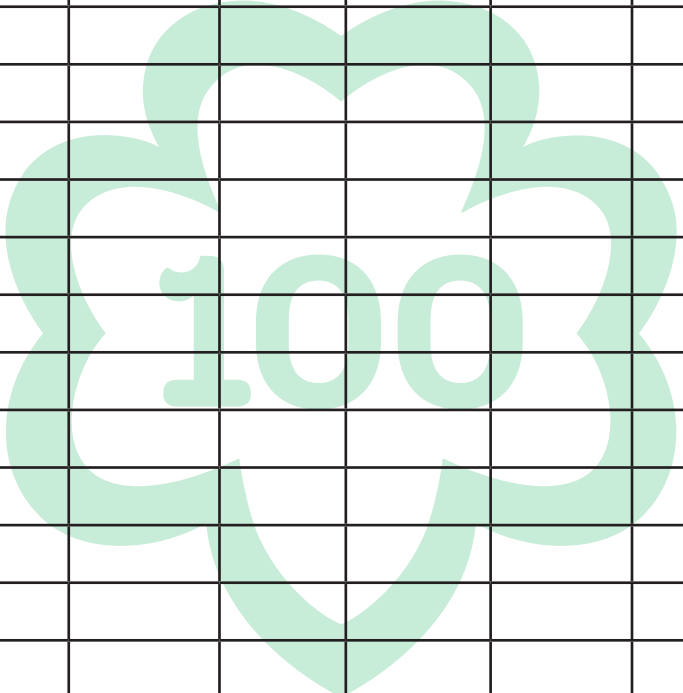
