Day camp is for all girls entering grades K-12 in the fall of 2013. A girl must be or become a registered Girl Scout to attend camp.* Girl Scouts welcomes all girls regardless of race, color, religion, national origin or ability.



*If a girl is not a registered Girl Scout at the time of camp registration, she may become a Girl Scout by paying the non-refundable \$20 annual fee for the October 1, 2012 to September 30, 2013 membership year.

How to Register

- 1. Read this brochure with your daughter and identify the sessions that interest her.
- Complete the 2013 Day Camp Registration Form (online at girlscoutcamp. org).

*Paper registrations may be mailed, faxed, e-mailed or delivered to your nearest Girl Scouts Heart of Michigan Regional Center (see page 4 for locations). A \$25 non-refundable deposit must be included at time of registration.

How to Apply for Financial Assistance

Financial assistance is available for registered members of Girl Scouts Heart of Michigan to help families send their daughters to camp. Assistance is awarded based on need and will not exceed \$250 per camp season.

Complete and return the Financial Assistance Request Form (online at girlscoutcamp. org) with your 2013 Day Camp Registration Form and \$25 non-refundable deposit. You will be notified within two weeks of your application being processed.

What's Next?

- Within two weeks of processing your registration, you will receive an invoice confirming your daughter's placement which will also include a balance due summary. You may pay your balance with Cookie Cash or Camp Credit. Girl Scouts Heart of Michigan gift card, cash, check or credit card.
- 2. Visit girlscoutcamp. org to find your session's Information Packet and to download the required forms. If you do not have Internet access, please call us at (800) 49-SCOUT to have printed copies mailed to you.
- 3. The balance of all camp fees must be paid in full, or payment arrangements made two weeks prior to the session start date (An unpaid balance will result in the cancellation of your daughter's registration).
