**What to bring to Girl Scout Day Camp**  
Please bring a water bottle and sunscreen, and bug spray for days spent outside. A small daypack is perfect for keeping everything together!

Please bring a sack lunch.

**Kalamazoo Day Camp Lunch**  
Girls will eat a sack lunch. You may bring your own or purchase for \$25/week. An example lunch could be: turkey/cheese wrap, chips, fruit, and cookie.

## The Details

- Drop-off from 7:45 to 9:00 a.m, programming from 9:00 to 5:00, pick-up from 5:00 to 6:00 p.m. Parent program Fridays at 5:00 p.m.
- Easy Online Registration at [GirlScoutCamp.org](http://GirlScoutCamp.org)
- You can choose to deposit your camper's Trading Post (camp shop) spending money when you sign up for camp.
- Within two weeks of processing your camper's registration, we will email you an invoice confirming her placement which will include a Balance Due Summary. You may pay any balance with Cookie Cash, Cashew Cash, a Girl Scouts Heart of Michigan Gift Card, credit card, cash, or check.
- Campdoc.com allows you to complete all of your camp paperwork online—just once! You will receive a link once your registration has been processed.
- Pay your camp balance in full or make payment arrangements at least two weeks prior to the session start date.
- Financial Assistance is available based on need. Return a completed Financial Assistance Request Form with your camper's Day Camp Registration Form and \$25 deposit (non-refundable). Forms are available at [GirlScoutCamp.org](http://GirlScoutCamp.org) You will be notified within two weeks of the application being processed.

### Day Camp Refund Policy

Our hope is that you always find a session or two...or three, that works. However, we understand life happens, so we're able to issue a partial refund for the circumstances outlined below.

Refund Amount	Reason
Refund minus \$25	Medical reason*
Refund minus \$25	Non-medical reason where cancellation is received four weeks prior to camp session start
50% refund	Non-medical reason where cancellation is received two weeks prior to camp session start
50% refund	Family emergency
Full refund	Only if you are not selected for the camp program of your first or second choice —OR— when a program is canceled due to insufficient enrollment and you cannot be placed in your second choice program.

\*If a camper cancels for medical reasons, the camp must be notified by the first day of her session and a written notice from her doctor must be provided within two weeks of her camp session.
