The State of Michigan has selected the Girl Scouts Heart of Michigan Troop 609 to serve as one of the Mackinac Island Governor's Honor Guard again this year. This represents our **41st year** of service to the state of Michigan!

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The summer of 2019 will mark Troop 609's 41st year of outstanding service to the Mackinac Island Scout Service Camp. Thousands of visitors from all over the world visit Mackinac Island each summer. As these visitors tour historic Fort Mackinac and the other state park buildings, they are greeted by Girl Scout and Boy Scout troops that are vital to the operations of the site. In order to become a member of the Honor Guard, you must be willing to dedicate yourself to serving the people and the State of Michigan. All 6th – 12th grade, at the time of selection, registered Girl Scouts are eligible to apply. You must be a full time Michigan resident.

EVENT FEE

All girls – **\$240.00**

- After the selection weekend, girls will receive a letter notifying them of their status with the Honor Guard. The status is either selected, alternate or not selected.
- As a selected member of the Honor Guard an Acceptance of Responsibility form, partial payment of at least \$100, cookie cash and/or financial aid application will be due at planning weekend. The final balance is due 6/1.
- As an alternate member of the Honor Guard an Acceptance of Responsibility form will be due at planning weekend. Final payment is due within two weeks of being activated..

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

If needed, you must apply for financial assistance by the acceptance letter due date at May planning

- **Heart of Michigan** – bring the original copy of your financial assistance application form with your acceptance letter to planning weekend.

UNIFORM

The uniform cost for new girls is approximately \$125. Some items are wearable outside of the program. Returning girls may need to update parts of their uniform as well due to changes in the uniform. When you are no longer in the Honor Guard, you may sell pieces to girls in the program if they are still a part of the current uniform.

Some items have been donated from former scouts. They will be available on a first come first serve basis at planning

SELECTION CRITERIA

Within two weeks of the application deadline a packet of information will be mailed to all applicants inviting them to selection weekend at the date and time listed on the front of this packet.

During selection weekend girls will participate in various activities including marching, flag folding, interview and teambuilding. Girls will be graded on application content, reference materials, performance at selection weekend as well as previous year's performance if applicable. The week after selection letters will be mailed to all

applicants letting them know if they were selected and information needed for the following training.

APPLICATION AND TWO CONFIDENTIAL REFERENCES

An application and two confidential references are included in this packet. Missing photos or incomplete information will reflect negatively on you.

The references should be from a **non-family** member only. This could be a teacher, Girl Scout adult, church member, family friend, or any other adult over the age of 18 who has known you for at least one year. They are to mail the letters of recommendations **directly** to the address listed on the form.

Application and confidential references must be postmarked by March 22nd !!!

BEFORE YOU APPLY

Please read and understand the entire application packet. Keep in mind the following information:

1. This program is a privilege, not a right.
2. You may need to choose the Honor Guard program over other activities you want to participate in this summer.
3. Any absences you want excused (including leaving early or arriving late) need to be indicated on the application. Each case will be considered on an individual basis. Not all absences will be approved. No absences will be allowed for July Training.
4. If you feel you cannot commit entirely to this program, please do not apply this year. You may try again next year.
