**Science, Engineering, and Math, Oh my!**

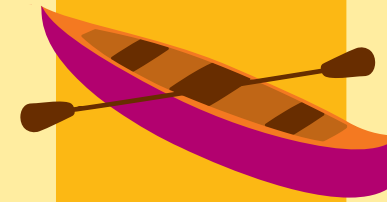
Find out how STEM fits into your everyday life! Girls will explore the science of food, use engineering techniques to build forts, and practice making a budget for a stuffed animal tea party.
