Gold Award Spotlight



Gold Award Girl Scouts plan and execute incredible projects that have sustainable impacts on their communities.



Krunali, from our Ann Arbor Region, completed her Gold Award by developing tools for the classroom to assist students in managing their levels of stress. Children with learning disabilities sometimes have difficulty completing their homework assignments and quizzes because of anxiety. Krunali worked with middle school students with learning disabilities in the school's resource room. She created educational tools that included worry beads, sensory bean bags, and positive motivation cards. Krunali made a variety of tools for teachers to use, and instructions to make additional educational tools when needed.
