#### ATTENDANCE POLICY

It is important to have the entire troop together for trainings. We are a team that depends on each other to accomplish our duties. To be part of Junior Leadership it is required to be present at each training weekend. As a member of JL you can have one conflict by leaving early or coming late, but must attend a portion of every training.

#### **PROGRAM FEE**

Returning girls - \$325.00

- A \$50 deposit must accompany the application, this deposit will be refunded if a participant is not selected, however, the deposit will be forfeited if applicant drops out after being selected or does not show up to first training.
- Payment schedule:
  - o Deposit due (\$50) with application
  - Payment of \$300 for new girls and \$275 for returning girls, cookie cash and/or Financial Aid is due on 4/5 at the Basic Training Weekend.
- Program fee is nonrefundable once the acceptance of responsibility is signed and submitted.
- As an alternate, any fees paid minus the \$50 deposit will be refunded when all items that were provided (uniform, program book etc) are returned.

## **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

If needed, you must apply for financial assistance from your own council.

• **GS Heart of Michigan** – a link to the application will be provided upon acceptance into the program as needed

#### **UNIFORM**

Uniform pieces that have been previously provided include a white nylon jacket, a clear poncho, and two uniform shirts. If you have outgrown your pieces bring them to the April Basic Training meeting to be exchanged for new pieces. If you have lost your pieces there is a fee to order new ones. Additional items that will need to be purchased include shorts, shoes, socks and watch. A current GSUSA approved vest is needed with a few minor modifications for Troop 609. All this information will be provided at the April meeting and full uniform is required by the May meeting.

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

An interview will be conducted via zoom the weekend of March 3<sup>rd</sup>. Interview times will be for thirty minutes. Emails will be sent to schedule times for the interviews. Selection will be based on the application, references and the zoom interview.

#### APPLICATION

The Junior Leadership Application is include in this packet. Also, required to be submitted with this application is the roster of girls to whom the applicant spoke to regarding the MISSP. Completed Troop 609 Leadership IPP is required. Leadership IPP can be submitted with application or any time prior.

Application must be received by February 21st!!

## **BEFORE YOU APPLY**

Please read and understand the entire application packet. Keep in mind the following information:

- 1. This program is a privilege, not a right.
- 2. You may need to choose Troop 609 over other activities you want to participate in this summer.
- 3. Any absences you want excused (including leaving early or arriving late) need to be indicated on the application. Each case will be considered on an individual basis. Not all absences will be approved. If you will be missing a training, this could impact your JL selection.
- 4. If you feel you cannot commit entirely to this program, please do not apply this year. You may try again next year.
