The State of Michigan has selected the Girl Scouts Heart of Michigan Troop 609 to serve at the Mackinac Island Scout Service Camp again this year. This represents our **47th year** of service to the state of Michigan!

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The summer of 2027 will mark Troop 609's 47th year of outstanding service to the Mackinac Island Scout Service Camp. Thousands of visitors from all over the world visit Mackinac Island each summer. As these visitors tour historic Fort Mackinac and the other state park buildings, they are greeted by Girl Scout and Boy Scout troops that are vital to the operations of the site. The people of Mackinac Island have pride in our standards and us. It is our responsibility to give them our very best!

In order to become a member of the Scout Service Camp, you must be willing to dedicate yourself to serving the people and the State of Michigan. Service is our first priority – flag duty, guide duty, service projects, and KP duties – before your own personal free time and the other fun you may participate in during your stay on Mackinac Island.

ELIGIBILITY/APPLICATION

To apply for Junior Leadership, you must have served for two years with Troop 609, completed the leadership badge and promoted Troop 609 to a group or troop.

Application, sign in sheet/email from group or troop that you spoke with and the leadership badge must be received by January 29th!!

****Times subject to change, dates will not.** Junior Leadership typical arrives a few hours prior to the full troop. With the exception that June training they come the night before.

ATTENDANCE POLICY

It is important to have the entire troop together for trainings. We are a team that depends on each other to accomplish our duties. To be part of Junior Leadership it is required to be present at each training weekend. As a member of JL you can have one conflict by leaving early or coming late, but must attend a portion of every training.

PROGRAM FEE - \$375.00

- A \$50 deposit must accompany the application, this deposit will be refunded if a participant is not selected. The deposit will be forfeited if applicant drops out after being selected or does not show up to first training.
- Payment Schedule:
 - Deposit due (\$50) with application, remaining balance of \$325 is due at Basic Training on 4/10. Cookie Cash and Financial aid are due at the same time
- Program fee is nonrefundable once the acceptance of responsibility is signed and submitted.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

If needed, you must apply for financial assistance from your own council. For **GS Heart of Michigan** – a link will be provided after selection is completed.

What is included in the program fee:

1. Cost for all trainings weekends, all costs for the week on Mackinac Island with the exception of your personal transportation to and from Mackinaw City and any spending money while on the island.
2. Uniform – All details for the required uniform will be provided at the Basic Training. Some parts of the uniform may need to be purchased for a cost about \$100-\$150.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Within two weeks of the application deadline a packet of information will be mailed to all applicants inviting them to selection weekend at the date and time listed on the front of this packet. During the selection day, Junior Leader applicants will participate in leading various activities including marching, flag folding, and teambuilding. Girls will be graded on application content, performance at selection and basic training weekend as well as previous year's performance. The week after selection, letters will be emailed to all applicants letting them know if they were selected to Troop 609 and Junior Leadership positions will be announced at the following training.

BEFORE YOU APPLY

Please read and understand the entire application packet. Keep in mind the following information:

1. This program is a privilege, not a right.
2. You may need to choose Troop 609 over other activities you want to participate in this summer.
3. Any absences you want excused (including leaving early or arriving late) need to be indicated on the application. Each case will be considered on an individual basis. Not all absences will be approved. If you will be missing a training, this could impact your JL selection.
4. If you feel you cannot commit entirely to this program, please do not apply this year. You may try again next year.
