- Good behavior
- Positive and knowledgeable selling techniques
- Well-staged, tidy, and eye-catching booths
- Display their Girl Scout Uniform or Pins

Booth Etiquette & Guidelines Do This:

- Greet customers with a smile—even if they don't
- Thank all customers and the store manager/owner
- Be respectful to store employees and the property
- Keep booth tidy and well-staged
- Demonstrate knowledge of cookies and pricing

Avoid This:

- Eating at the booth
- Blocking entrances or high-traffic areas
- Loud talking or yelling
- Disorganized, cluttered displays
- Unprepared for customer questions
