On my honor, I, _____, will follow the rules listed below while working at my troop's cookie booth.

For Girl Scouts

I will

- Be polite and friendly
- Remember that my behavior reflects on all Girl Scouts
- Obey the booth sale starting date
- Arrive and leave on time
- Wear my uniform, vest or sash, or my pins to identify me as a Girl Scout
- Set up and sell only in our designated spot at the store
- Keep the table and area neat
- Say **thank you** to all I approach
- Remove empty boxes and trash, and will recycle when I am able

I will not

- Get in the way of customers
- Block entrances or exits to stores
- Go into the business unnecessarily while working at the booth
- Talk loudly, run around, or play at booth
- Eat, drink, or chew gum while selling at a cookie booth

For Adults

I will

- Be respectful all members of the Girl Scout troop
- Be a positive role model for all members of the Girl Scout troop
- Ensure my Girl Scout will arrive on time to her designated booth
- Arrive in the appropriate dress attire for the weather of the booth
- Ensure my Girl Scout is picked up on time at the end of the booth
- Be available/reachable in the event that the booth ends early due to weather or behavior

I will not

- Be rude or disrespectful to any customers or employees
- Argue with or disrespect in any way the leader or volunteer parents at the booth
- Argue with or disrespect in any way employees or management of the business
- Should I volunteer for the booth, I will not smoke or engage in any activity that is not appropriate for Girl Scouts
