




Badgefest: Code for Good *Plymouth*

Cadette Grade Level Essentials

Nov 19 - Virtual

After this course, participants will understand how to: implement girl-led, learn by doing (experiential learning cycle), and cooperative learning at a Girl Scout Cadette level; utilize and teach girls the LUTE (listen, understand, tolerate, empathize) model to empower girls to master their emotions; mentor and educate girls earning high level cadette awards; guide and support girls embarking on a troop or individual domestic, international, or outdoor adventure trip.

Youth Mental Health First Aid Training

Nov 23 - Virtual Jan 11 - Virtual

Designed to teach parents, family members, caregivers, teachers, school staff, peers, neighbors, health and human services workers, and other caring citizens how to identify, understand, and respond to an adolescent (ages 12-18) who is experiencing a mental health or substance use challenge or crisis. Mental Health First Aid helps you assist someone experiencing a mental health or substance use-related crisis. In this course, you will learn risk factors and warning signs for mental health and addiction concerns, strategies for how to help someone in both crisis and non-crisis situations, and where to turn for help.
