Cookies to Camp Program

Did you know that selling Girl Scout Cookies can help your Girl Scout get to summer camp? The Cookies to Camp Program makes outdoor adventures more accessible by allowing Girl Scouts to earn camp credit through their hard work in the Cookie Program.

Starting April 25, 2025, every Girl Scout who participates earns \$1.15 in camp credit for every package sold, which is loaded onto a Cookies to Camp Card—exclusively for Girl Scouts Heart of Michigan summer camp experiences.

That means:

375 packages = One Overnight Mini Session **480 packages** = One week of Overnight Camp

600 packages = One week of Horse Camp



Encourage your Girl Scout to set her sights on camp this summer. When she sells cookies this season, she's not just building on the five skills or the cookie program; she's earning her way to a lifetime of friendship and memories.
