S.T.E.A.M (SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, ART AND MATHEMATICS)


Discover the world all around you!

· Learn all the words to 'Make New Friends', and invite a friend to participate with you


















#### LIFE SKILLS

Celebrate your accomplishments big or small!





- · New level in Girl Scouts? Get your new uniform and learn how to iron or sew on badges

Become an expert at decision making and setting goals!







- Work on your people skills by writing a speech to share why you love Girl Scouts
