The committee will review applications, select candidates for interviews, conduct interviews and determine the slate for the Girl Scouts Heart of Michigan Board Meeting to be held in March 2025. The Board of Trustees will elect/approve the delegates at that meeting.

This is a vital position for Girl Scouts Heart of Michigan. Please review the National Delegate Requirements and Role to be a Delegate thoroughly before submitting your application. Briefly, delegates are required to:

- Attend orientation, training and at least one additional meeting prior to the convention.
- Attend all sessions in Washington, DC.
- Serve as a National Council Delegate for three years and participate in occasional National Meetings via teleconference during that period.
- Serve on the Girl Scouts Heart of Michigan Member Advisory Committee (MAC) for three years.
- Report on the convention to the Girl Scouts Heart of Michigan membership.
- Be a citizen of the USA, registered Girl Scout and at least 14 years of age by March 29, 2025.

Girl Scouts Heart of Michigan will cover National Council Session/Convention registration fees for adult and girl delegates, as well as hotel and transportation expenses for girl delegates. Adult delegates would be responsible for their own hotel and transportation expenses. Any other additional expenses will be the responsibility of each delegate. Financial scholarships will be available. Contributions towards expenses incurred by Girl Scouts Heart of Michigan are welcome.
