This form encompasses membership year activities, and must be turned in to the Service Unit Manager (if no Service Unit Manager, submit directly to your Troop Support Specialist) for review. Once the Service Unit Manager completes the review it is sent to the Troop Support Specialist for approval.

Upon approval, the troop leader will be notified by email or letter. The email or letter must be presented at a regional Girl Scout Shop in order to obtain awards. Troops with approved awards will also have the option to purchase Honor Troop or Honor Troop Plus flag ribbons.

To be considered for the Honor Troop Award, troops must complete all of the items listed on page two. Troops also have the opportunity to be considered for the Honor Troop Plus Award. This requires the completion of five or more additional items, which you will find on page three of this form.
